#### MONTHLY TOPIC: FOODS THAT CAN STAIN TEETH & CERAMIC BRACES

You probably already know that there are lots of different foods that if consumed on a regular basis will stain your teeth. Your teeth are porous, which means that they naturally absorb the liquid that you put into your body. Most of the same foods that can stain your teeth will also stain the clear ties often used with ceramic (clear) braces. The rule of thumb is that if it could stain a white shirt, your lips, tongue, hands, or a cutting board, it will stain your teeth and also the clear ties. The following is a list of beverages and foods to be cautious with throughout the course of orthodontic treatment. Some of these do not really apply to children, but are always good for adults with braces to keep in mind:

#### 1. Coffee

Coffee drinks, especially black coffee, will stain your teeth and ceramic braces.

#### 2. Tea


The darker the tea is, the more likely it is to stain your teeth. If you just can't kick the tea habit, choose green or white over black teas. These will probably still stain your teeth, just not as much as dark teas.

#### 3. Soda

Dark colored soda is bad for you on many different levels, but is also very bad for your teeth. Not only does it bathe your teeth in artificial sugar and acid (two things that are very bad for your enamel), it also contains dark colors that will stain your teeth, especially if you drink it every single day.

#### 4. Dark juices

Berry based juices (such as grape





and cranberry) are the biggest culprits. While these juices can help you get your servings of fruit, they are also concentrated sources of dark pigments, which can stain teeth and ceramic braces.

#### 5. Popsicles

Kids love popsicles, so try to pick something lighter in color. Avoid the red and blue color based ones.

#### 6. Soy sauce

Any dark liquid has the potential for one of the foods that stain your teeth, but soy sauce especially has the possibility of leaving behind a stain (because it is so concentrated). Use soy sauce sparingly—because it is high in sodium, as well as being a dark liquid.

#### 7. Balsamic vinegar

This is another dark color liquid that gives it the potential for staining your teeth and ceramic braces.

Because balsamic vinegar is acidic, it will naturally stick to your teeth.

#### 8. Tomato sauce

Tomato sauce is a staple in many households. No matter what version you prefer, anything that is tomato-based can stain your teeth and ceramic braces.

#### 9. Dark Berries

Blueberries, strawberries, raspberries, cherries, etc. all are likely to stain teeth and ceramic braces.

#### 10. Beets

If you have ever handled a beet, you know how easily they stain everything they touch - including teeth and ceramic braces.

Rinsing your mouth after eating these beverages and foods usually will not be enough. Brushing your teeth within an hour of consumption is usually the best way to prevent stains.

Each month we feature a different color combination you can get on your braces with the elastic ties! We even give the color combination a fun, cool name and have it on display so you can see what it will look like! This month's colors were designed by one of our assistants, Heather! Due to the fact that insurance policies vary, we can only estimate your coverage in good faith, but cannot guarantee coverage due to the complexities of insurance contracts. Please inform us, too, of any changes to your insurance coverage.











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
