ORTHODONTIC TOPIC: WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR 1ST ORTHODONTIC APPOINTMENT

The initial consultation for braces is an hour long complimentary, appointment for both adults and children. You will meet with our treatment coordinator, Jean, and she will start off by giving you a tour of our office. After the tour, Jean will review the health history form with you and discuss any concerns that you or the dentist may have. She will then proceed with taking records, including x-rays and close- up photographs of the face and teeth.

Once the records have been obtained, Dr. Spoonhower will review them and do a thorough exam of the mouth. He will discuss any recommended orthodontic treatment with you and Jean will also show you the braces, any appliances that may be recommended, explain in detail the process, and what to expect from start to finish. Jean will also present all of the financial information and office protocols. You will leave with a folder containing a copy of all of the records that were taken, the treatment plan and financial information so that you have all of the information you need to make an informed decision about starting orthodontic treatment with our office.

We may be biased - but once you start treatment with us, you become family and we do everything to make you feel comfortable, welcome and have fun along the way!

Due to the fact that insurance policies vary, we can only estimate your coverage in good faith, but cannot guarantee coverage due to the complexities of insurance contracts. Please inform us, too, of any changes to your insurance coverage.
