# ORTHODONTIC TOPIC: THE IMPORTANCE OF ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT AT A YOUNG AGE

Research has shown that serious orthodontic problems can be more easily corrected when the patient's skeleton is still growing and flexible. By correcting the skeletal problems at a younger age we can prepare the mouth for the eventual eruption of the permanent teeth. If the permanent teeth have adequate space to erupt they will come in fairly straight. If the fairly teeth erupt straight their tendency to get crooked again after the braces come off is diminished significantly. Once the permanent teeth have erupted, usually between the ages of 12-14, complete braces are placed for final alignment and detailing of the bite. Thus the final stage of treatment is quicker and easier on the patient and usually lasts from 12-18 months.

Doing orthodontic treatment in two phases provides excellent results often allowing time for the removal of permanent teeth and jaw surgery if necessary. Treatment done when some of the baby teeth are still present is referred to as Phase 1 treatment. Treatment after all of the permanent teeth have erupted is referred to as Phase 2 treatment. If you have any questions regarding the timing of starting orthodontic treatment, please do not hesitate to contact our office.

Regarding Insurance: If your insurance covers orthodontic treatment, you will be reimbursed directly from your insurance company. This will reduce your overall out of pocket expense for treatment. Many insurance policies have a lifetime orthodontic benefit that is distinct from regular dental insurance. Insurance policies vary, so we will review your insurance to determine the appropriate course of action. (Once treatment has started, we will file your claims).

Our office is committed to helping you maximize your insurance benefits. Due to the fact that insurance policies vary, we can only estimate your coverage in good faith, but cannot guarantee coverage due to the complexities of insurance contracts. Please inform us, too, of any changes to your insurance coverage.
